With an unusually cold winter that does not seem to relent, we are looking forward to the promise of bright sunshine and spring air just around the corner. Our focus for this month will be on signs of spring, learning about life cycles, spring babies and spring celebrations.

We welcome all Dads (and Moms) for **Go Western Day on March 6** from 8:30 a.m. – 10:00 a.m. Your child(ren) will be thrilled to have you participate in their class projects. Our **Book Fair** started this morning with a visit from The Cat in the Hat in honor of Dr. Seuss' 111th birthday and a mesmerizing book reading by Silvania Poindexter. Be sure to visit the **Book Fair in the Art room. March 26th is International Day** at the elementary/middle school. All contracts end at the end of May, however if you would like your child(ren) to attend summer school/camps in June and/or July, please see the programs we are offering below:

TK Summer Camp – This is a weekly camp for 10 weeks of summer. It will include fun hands-on projects, journal writing, specialty classes Spanish and Art, reading buddies, math challenges, once a week in-house or off of campus field trips. This program is open to our current TK students as well as students entering Kindergarten from area schools.

Power K – a monthly program where the focus is on enrichment and getting ready for our Kindergarten. The program will be open to only TK students or new students enrolled in our Kindergarten for the Fall semester..

Summer Fun for Pre-K and Toddlers- We will continue with our monthly Toddler and Pre-K Summer Fun program starting June 1 – July 31. Specialty classes will include, Art, P.E., Spanish and we will have special days like Bring Your Bike to School Day, Teddy Bear's Picnic, Dress Up Day and Splash Day. Special in-house field trips will be included twice a month.

Power TK – This is a great enrichment monthly program for all Pre-K students enrolled in TK for the Fall semester and will include Summer Fun activities as well.

Summer Camps and Enrichment programs for Elementary students- 10 weeks of camps and enrichment programs open to our students as well as students from the community.
