Please see the summer programs we are offering below: Summer Fun for Pre-K and Toddlers- Our summer fun program begins on May 31 -July 29 with dress up days, parades, bring your bike to school day, etc. Specialty classes include Spanish, Art and P.E. Brochures for our summer fun program will go home soon. *********** Power TK -ls a monthly enrichment program for June and July for students entering TK in the fall. Kindergarten Summer Camp – 10 weeks of camp for students going into Kindergarten. The camp will start on May 31st and continue through August 5th, 2016. Students from other schools entering K (public or private) are welcome to join the camp. The program will include Specialty Classes, Spanish, Art, P.E. and Computer, as well as in -house /outdoor field trips. While the children will follow a fun theme-based curriculum, journal writing, reading and math will be a part of the program as well. Extended care is available from 6:30 - 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 - 6:30 p.m. Lunch will be included in the tuition. Brochures for this camp will go home soon. Power K – Is a monthly enrichment program for June and July with a focus on Reading, Writing and Math. Students attending Kindergarten at our school or public school are welcome to attend this program. This program includes Specialty classes Spanish, Art, P.E. and Computer as well as lunch and field trips. Please note our school will be completely closed for teacher in-service week on August 8-12. TK, Pre-K and Toddler Orientations will be held on August 12 from 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. The first day of school for the new school-year at ECP is August 15 2016.
